The District Attorney of Centre County, by this Information, charges that the Defendant, in the County of Centre, did:

Count 1. Firearms not to be carried w/o a lic. ; 18 Pa.C.S.A. 6106(a)(1); F3

on or about September 2, 2008, at District Court 49-3-05, 121 S. Pugh Street, Borough of State College, Centre County, Pennsylvania, unlawfully carry a firearm in any vehicle or concealed on or about his person, without a valid and lawful license, said location not being his place of abode or fixed place of business, namely a Kel Tec .380 calibre handgun,

Count 2. Firearms not to be carried w/o a lic. ; 18 Pa.C.S.A. 6106a(2); M1

on or about September 2, 2008, at the aforesaid location, being eligible to possess a valid license under this chapter, did unlawfully carry a firearm in any vehicle, or did carry a firearm concealed on or about his person, without a valid and lawfully issued license and had not committed any other criminal violation and said location not being in his place of abode or fixed place of business, namely a Kel Tec .380 calibre handgun,

Count 3. Possession of Firearm or Other Dangerous Weapon in Court Facility; 18 Pa.C.S.A. 913(a)(1); M3

on or about September 2, 2008, at the aforesaid location, did knowingly possess a firearm or other dangerous weapon in a court facility or knowingly cause a firearm or other dangerous weapon to be present in a court facility, namely a Kel Tec .380 calibre handgun,

All of which is against the Act of Assembly and the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania,
